Notice is hereby given that the Board of Directors of Cinco Municipal Utility District No. 8 will hold a regular meeting, open to the public, on **TUESDAY, 23 OCTOBER 2012**, at **12:00 noon**, at the offices of Coats, Rose, Yale, Ryman & Lee, P.C., 3 East Greenway Plaza, Suite 2000, Houston, Texas 77046-0307, outside the boundaries of the District, to consider and act upon the following matters:

1. Comments and questions from the public;
2. Presentation by the Cinco Ranch Landscape Maintenance Association regarding funding for 2013 improvement projects and authorize any necessary action;
3. Approval of the minutes of the meeting of 25 September 2012;
4. Tax Assessor/Collector's Report, including:
 - (a) disbursement of funds from the District's tax account;
 - (b) approval of any action necessary regarding accounts delinquent in the payment of taxes, penalties, and interest due to the District, including termination of services;
5. Bookkeeper's Report, including:
 - (a) authorize payment of the bills of the District;
 - (b) review investments of the District's funds;
 - (c) amend the District's Operating Budget for the fiscal year ending 31 August 2013;
