Notice is hereby given that the Board of Directors of Cinco Municipal Utility District No. 8 will hold a regular meeting, open to the public, on **TUESDAY, 23 JULY 2019**, at **12:00 noon**, at the offices of Coats Rose, P.C., 9 Greenway Plaza, Suite 1000, Houston, Texas 77046, outside the boundaries of the District, to consider and act upon the following matters:

1. Comments and questions from residents of the District (five-minute time limit);
2. Approval of the minutes of the meeting 25 June 2019;
3. Tax Assessor/Collector's Report, including:
  - (a) disbursement of funds from the District's tax account;
  - (b) approval of any action necessary regarding delinquent tax accounts, including termination of services;
4. Bookkeeper's Report, including:
  - (a) authorize payment of the bills of the District;
  - (b) review investments of the District's funds;
5. Old business, including:
  - (a) status of Hurricane Harvey Litigation by Vujasinovic & Beckcom PLLC;
  - (b) status of claim for reimbursement from the Federal Emergency Management Agency;
  - (c) review of security report from the Fort Bend County Precinct 3 Constable's Office;
  - (d) status of the District's website;
  - (e) status of maintenance of the District's detention ponds;
  - (f) status of the District's solid waste collection with Best Trash, LLC (solid waste collection agreement expires 1 September 2024; 60-day termination notice);
  - (g) status of Agreement for Collection of Soft Recyclables between the District and Great Lakes Recycling, Inc. d/b/a Simple Recycling;
6. New business, including:
  - (a) consider repairs to lift station fencing;
  - (b) consider construction of sidewalk to be completed along F.M. 1093 at Mason Road by the Chevron gasoline station;

7. Water conservation matters, including:
  - (a) review of activities of the North Fort Bend Water Authority; consider purchase of rain barrels;
  - (b) discussion regarding communication, measures, education, and budget, including the Fix a Leak Program; consider purchase of leak detector strips;
  - (c) consider Director attendance at the Association of Water Board Directors Summer Workshop (23 August 2019);
  - (d) status of the W.I.S.E. Guys Program;

  - (a) report on operations of the District's facilities;

  - (e) status of installation of mounted security lighting at the District's lift station site;
  - (f) status of repairs to the driveway located at 6203 Canyon Rock Way in the District (Edustrial Solutions);
